RENO, Nev. (KOLO) - Washoe County and the Nevada Division of Insurance will be hosting a meeting on homeowners insurance related to wildfire.

The event will be held at 5:30 p.m. on Feb. 24 at the Washoe County Administration Complex at 1001 E. 9th Street, building A.

New laws enacted during the 2025 Nevada Legislative Session will impact how insurance companies assess wildfire risk, potentially affecting insurance availability, coverage and premium rates for some homeowners.

Presenters will give an overview of the new law and how it pertains to homeowners in fire prone areas of Washoe County, as well as how insurers may implement the provisions.

After the presentation, representatives from the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District and Washoe County Emergency Management will discuss wildfire preparedness and risk-reduction efforts.

"Wildfire happens frequently in our area, and every resident should understand the threat and how they can help protect themselves and their family," Emergency Manager Kelly Echeverria said. "We are proud to partner with the State of Nevada to provide this important forum for education and dialogue with residents."
